DETR Releases Local Area Employment Statistics for May

According to the Nevada Department of Employment, Training and Rehabilitation's (<u>DETR</u>) May 2025 economic report, the state's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 5.5 percent in May 2025 which decreased by 0.1 percentage points (pp) from April 2025. Seasonally adjusted estimates account for regularly seen economic patterns, with the following estimates not seasonally adjusted.

In the three Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSA), the unemployment rates were 5.5 percent in the Las Vegas area, 4.3 percent in Reno, and 4.2 percent in the Carson area in May 2025.

In Nevada's counties, the lowest unemployment rate was in White Pine County at 3.8 percent, and Mineral County had the highest rate at 11.7 percent. For a look at the unemployment rate in your county, visit our <u>Area Profiles Page</u>.

In May 2025, the seasonally adjusted unemployment rate in Nevada decreased by 0.1 pp from 5.6 percent to 5.5 percent. The unadjusted rate went up by 0.2 pp from 5.0 percent to 5.2 percent. The number of employed individuals in the state went up by 5,057.

At the MSA (Metropolitan Statistical Area) level, the state saw an increase in the unemployment rate in all three of its MSAs. In the Las Vegas MSA, the state saw an increase of 0.3 pp, moving from 5.2 percent to 5.5 percent. The Carson City MSA saw an increase of 0.1 pp, going from 4.1 percent to 4.2 percent. The Reno – Sparks MSA saw an increase of 0.1 pp, going from 4.2 percent to 4.3 percent. These figures are not adjusted for seasonality.


At the county level, the state saw four counties' unemployment rates remain unchanged. These counties were White Pine, Douglas, Lyon, and Lincoln. Meanwhile, Esmeralda County saw a decrease in the unemployment rate of 1.3 pp. The largest increases were seen in Mineral and Humboldt with increases in the unemployment rate of 2.7 pp and 0.4 pp, respectively.

Figures for state unemployment estimates come from the Local Area Unemployment Statistics (LAUS) program, a state/federal partnership sponsored by the Bureau of Labor Statistics (BLS-LAUS). This program produces monthly and annual employment, unemployment, and labor force data for census regions, states, counties, metropolitan areas, and many large cities, based on place of residence. Seasonally adjusted estimates account for regularly seen seasonal employment patterns such as jobs associated with holiday hiring, holiday and weather seasons, or other jobs with seasonal components. The result of a seasonally adjusted estimate is usually a smoother estimate from which underlying economic trends can be seen. Adjusted estimates are in the summary table above, and in many of the other tables and figures throughout this document.

Nevada's seasonally adjusted unemployment rate was 5.5 percent in May, which decreased by 0.1 pp from 5.6 percent in April, and was unchanged from 5.5 percent in 2024. The number of unemployed individuals decreased by 1,573 from April to a current level of 92,014 people, which increased by 1,701 unemployed people since 2024. The labor force in Nevada is currently 1,678,275 people, which has increased by 3,484 people since April, and increased by 33,662 people since 2024.




The Las Vegas Metropolitan Statistical Area's (MSA) unemployment rate was 5.5 percent in May 2025, increasing from 5.2 percent in April 2025, and the same as 5.5 percent in May 2024, non-seasonally adjusted. The number of unemployed individuals increased by 3,299 since April 2025 for a current level of 68,274 people, which is 1,027 more unemployed people than May 2024. The labor force in Las Vegas is currently 1,245,526 people, which is 5,382 more people than April 2025, and is up 30,112 people since May 2024.

The Reno MSA's unemployment rate was 4.3 percent in May 2025, increasing from 4.2 percent in April 2025, and down from 4.7 percent in May 2024, non-seasonally adjusted. The number of unemployed individuals increased by 332 since April 2025 for a current level of 13,215 people, which is 812 less unemployed people than May 2024. The labor force in Reno is currently 306,779 people, which is 108 less people than April 2025, and is up 7,943 people since May 2024.

The Carson City MSA's unemployment rate was 4.2 percent in May 2025, increasing from 4.1 percent in April 2025, and down from 4.5 percent in May 2024, non-seasonally adjusted. The number of unemployed individuals increased by 57 since April 2025 for a current level of 1,278 people, which is 35 less unemployed people than May 2024. The labor force in Carson City is currently 30,141 people, which is 110 more people than April 2025, and is up 904 people since May 2024.

Unemployment Insurance Benefits


In May 2025, 11,369 initial claims for unemployment insurance were filed in Nevada, a decrease of 401 claims, or 3.4 percent, from April 2025 when there were 11,770 claims. This is also a higher number of claims than were seen in May 2024, when there were 10,924 initial claims.

Looking to our measures of unemployment insurance activity, final payments were down across the state. First payments saw an increase over the month. In Clark County, for example, first payments increased by 22 up to 4,424 or a percentage increase of 0.5%. Final Payments decreased by 183 down to 1,740 or a percentage decrease of 9.5%. Washoe County saw a decrease in first payments, with first payments going down by 10 from 572 to 562. Final payments in Washoe County were up by 8 from 236 to 244. Carson City experienced a decrease in first payments moving from 72 to 56 or a decrease of 16. Final payments in Carson City were up 11, moving from 23 to 34. Statewide, the Weeks Compensated decreased by 3,479 or 4% over the month. Benefit Payments made decreased by approximately \$1.37 million or 3.4%.


Initial Claims by County weekly claim totals since January 2020
