

## Nevada Gross Job Gains in Construction > Gross Job Losses 2018:IIQ Net Gain = 1,578 Jobs



- Business Employment Dynamics is a set of statistics generated from the Quarterly Census of Employment and Wages program. These quarterly data series consist of gross job gains and gross job losses statistics. These data help to provide a picture of the dynamic state of the labor market. In this research note we focus on a specific industry looking at gross job flows in construction.
- Gross job gains in construction at expanding or opening private sector establishments totaled 9,893 in 2018:IIQ, 13% of the total private gains in Nevada.; In 2018:IIQ, gross job losses at contracting or closing private sector establishments totaled 8,315.
- The difference between the number of gross job gains and the number of gross job losses equated to a "net" employment gain of 1,578 jobs in the private sector for this period. During 2018:IIQ, Nevada's net gain grew 16% exceeding the Nation (7.4%) by 8.5 percentage points. Gross Job Gains in construction over the 2014:IIQ- 2018:IIQ had gains in 15 of 18 quarters. Gross job gains have averaged 9,398 per quarter from, 2017:IIQ thru 2018:IIQ.
